The MS Centre is a specialised centre in Norway for persons with Multiple Sclerosis. It has a residential capacity for 21 users who stay in house for approximately four weeks. The centre has a consulting neurologist, nursing staff as well as a physiotherapy unit and an occupational therapy unit. A social worker is also attached to the centre.


We have used a MOTO-med, in our rehabilitation work for a couple of years and it has been a very useful aid instrument for the patient (user) group that is restricted from training on their own.

The MOTO-med allows the user to train and exercise over a longer period of time than he/she would be able to do otherwise. It also allows the user to exchange between active and passive movements.

Results of use

It is quite apparent that most users have a psychological well being after training with the MOTO-med. It also allows for greater movement of the lower limbs and increased blood circulation. This is very important for persons that have reduced mobility and that can be mentally and physically passive. Another observation that we have made is the marked reduction of swelling in the legs and feet of the users. The systematic use of the MOTO-med has resulted in increased strength and improved movement for the persons concerned.
